This course introduces participants to a comprehensive study of the homeland security system at the federal, state and local levels. It will analyze the structure of the U.S. homeland security system and operational areas as well as programs aimed at minimizing the nation's vulnerability to attacks. It is designed as an intensive technical writing course aimed at developing critical thinking skills and mastering technical writing in the discipline.

This course is offered to University of Houston students as an elective (3 Credit Hours) through the standard registration process. For those interested in taking the course in order to supplement the work experience in or with the Homeland Security Enterprise, this course is offered as one of four courses required for a certificate in Border Operations Management or Border, Trade, and Transport Security offered through the BTI Institute and the University of Houston College of Technology.
