

Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Traditional Track Course Requirement Checklist

Applicants interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) – Traditional Track at the University of Houston must fulfill the course requirements below.

From the list of required courses, 45 semester credit hours MUST be taken at UH.

AP/IB/Dual Credit can be used to fulfill the 45 semester credit hour requirements.

Only 15 semester credit hours earned through transfer coursework can be used to fulfill the below requirements.

<u>NOTE:</u> AP/IB/Dual Credit is not considered transfer coursework since it was earned during high school. Transfer coursework at the Gessner College of Nursing refers to college-level courses earned AFTER high school graduation.

Only two attempts per course, with **only the first two attempts considered**. *Grades of W are not counted as attempts.*

The College of Nursing HIGHLY encourages all applicants who earned AP credit for

CHEM 1305/1311, MATH 1342, and PSYC 2301

to repeat the credit for grade at UH. AP course content is not equivalent to college content, thus repeating the course for grade will demonstrate to the Admission Committee that the Applicant understands the content of the course.
