POLICY TITLE: STUDENT INVOLVEMENT IN CURRICULUM AND EVALUATION

Nursing student representatives have the opportunity to attend the College of Nursing (CON) faculty meetings. Student representatives will be invited to attend regularly scheduled faculty meetings during general discussion and will be dismissed prior to discussion of student progression or other sensitive issues.

Each academic year, a request for the election of class representatives will be sent to all UHCON students from the College of Nursing Office of Student Affairs. Class representatives to UHCON Undergraduate Committee faculty meetings will be selected by the students from each track in the undergraduate program. An alternate representative may also be selected. One graduate representative will be selected by students in the graduate program to attend the UHCON Graduate Committee faculty meeting. Students may attend virtually. Student representatives are encouraged to meet periodically with their corresponding Track Manager for specific track-related concerns. Comments and concerns presented at faculty meetings should relate to issues affecting the nursing program in general and not to specific courses. It is the responsibility of the student representative to elicit comments and concerns related to the nursing program from fellow students, to bring forward those comments and concerns, and to provide feedback to the students following the faculty meeting.
