<b>Job Description</b>	<p><b>Job Summary:</b></p> <p>The <b>Wendy's Wonderful Kids Recruiter</b> maintains a caseload of a minimum of 12 active youth and engages in child-center focused recruitment on the youths' behalf. The <b>WWK Recruiter</b> builds a relationship with the youth on their caseload and actively pursues locating a permanent family for the youth.</p> <p>A key strategy in the child-focused recruitment model used by the <b>Wendy's Wonderful Kids Recruiter</b> is to explore the child's history and contact people with whom the child has a preexisting relationship (such as relative, neighbors, mentors, teachers, pastors, etc.) who may become potential adoptive parents or sources of information to find a permanent home for that child. Finding a family who the child already knows can increase the child's comfort with and openness to adoption.
